CSRDE uses IPEDS traditional 100, 150 and 200 percent graduation rate definitions for first-time, full-time, baccalaureate degree-seeking students.

Only CSRDE reports data for first-time, full-time STEM degree-seeking students. For transfers, CSRDE collects data for full-time and part-time degree-seeking students transferring in from a 2-year institution. SAM transfer data and the new IPEDS Outcome Measures for transfer students include all transfers, not just those from 2-year institutions.***
