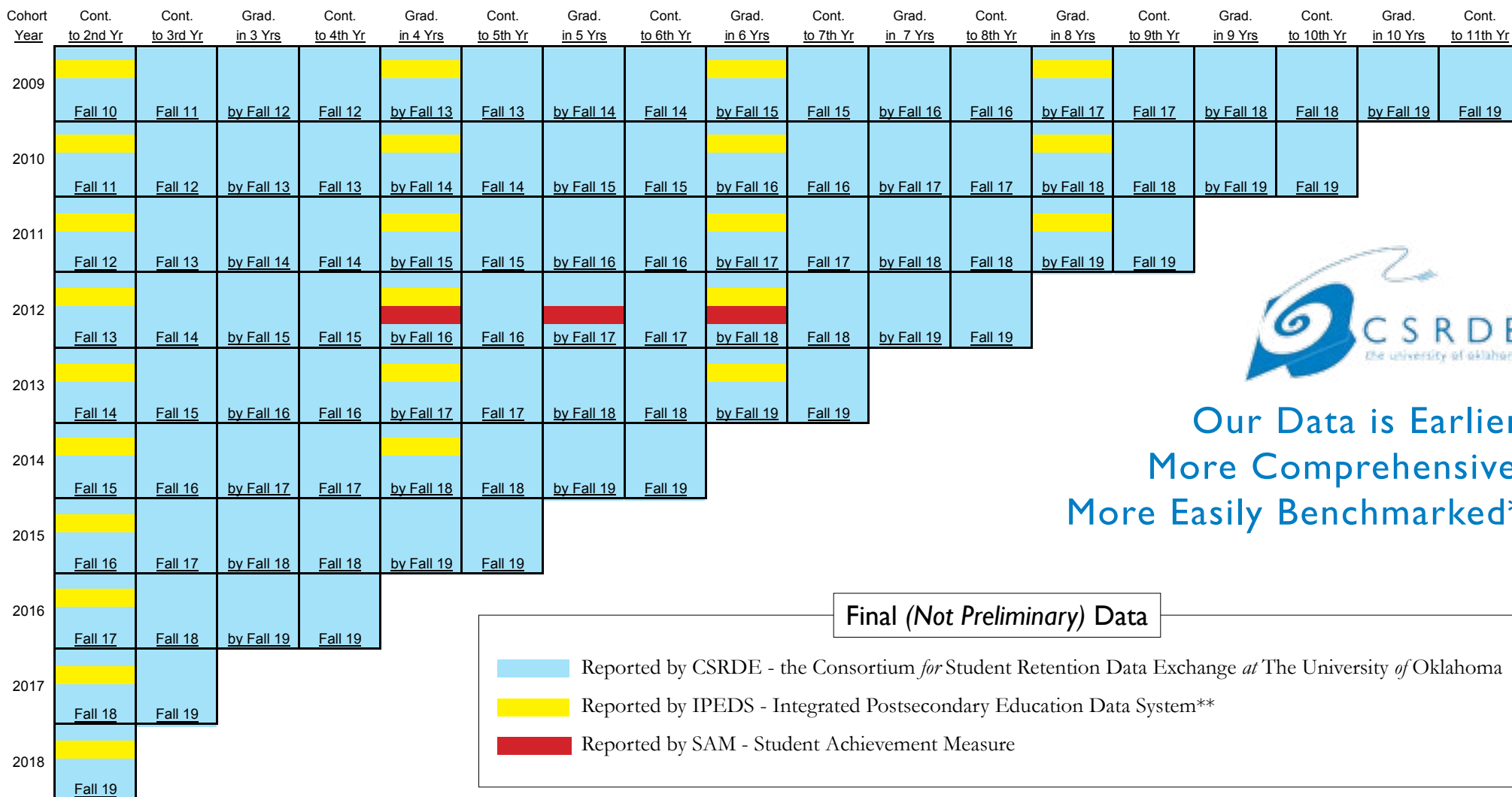


Four-Year Institution Report: CSRDE Data Points in Time Compared to Those Released by IPEDS and SAM

Data Points available as of May 2021



CSRDE uses IPEDS traditional 100, 150 and 200 percent graduation rate definitions for first-time, full-time, baccalaureate degree-seeking students.

Only CSRDE reports data for first-time, full-time STEM degree-seeking students. For transfers, CSRDE collects data for full-time and part-time degree-seeking students transferring in from a 2-year institution. SAM transfer data and the new IPEDS Outcome Measures for transfer students include all transfers, not just those from 2-year institutions.**

*All CSRDE report data is given by total cohort and broken down by gender and race/ethnicity.

**Neither IPEDS nor SAM differentiates between students with at least one year of college experience and those who may be simply taking a course or two at a 2-year institution. The definitions used in SAM and IPEDS Outcome Measures reports are slightly different.
